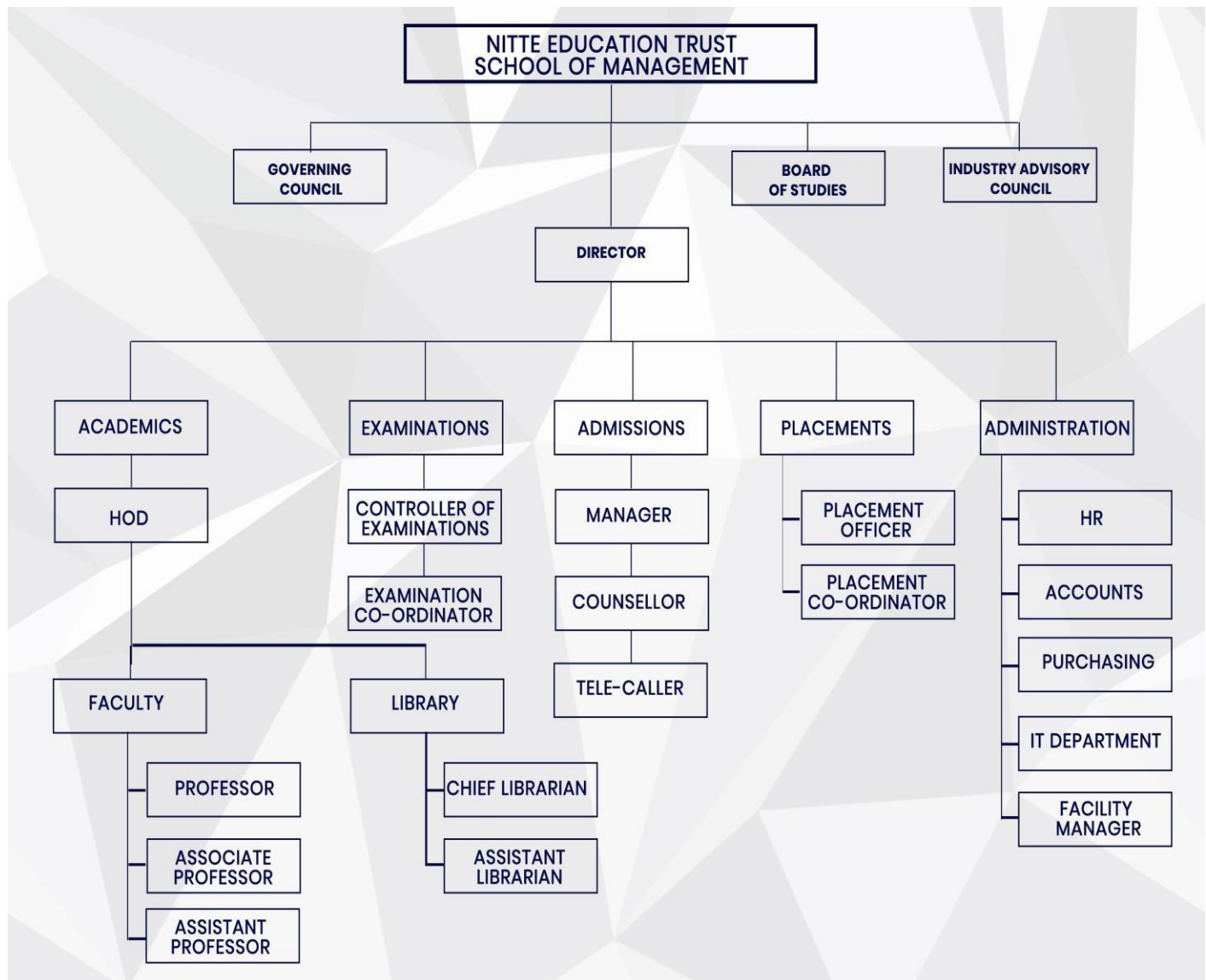

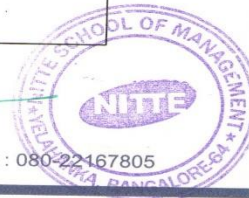

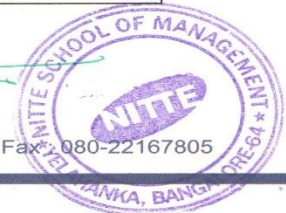

Classrooms & Learning Facilities

Nitte School of Management is spread over 2.75 Acres and has a variety of advanced infrastructure on 3720 sq.ft of built-up area. The brick and mortar infrastructure consist of modern campus facilities, including a hostel. There are 3 classrooms/lecture halls of varying seating capacities, from 20 to 70 participants. One Board Room have been exclusively designed for Executive Development Programs, apart from four small ones for regular meetings/interactions. A state-of-the-art auditorium is available for conducting conferences/seminars and events. These elements facilitate modern day pedagogy in an ecosystem which emulates the high-profile corporate design.

Being a fully residential campus NSOM has its own hostel. The hostel campus is completely Wi-Fi enabled and has well equipped single/double/triple occupancy rooms, made available on first come first serve basis. Facilities for indoor and outdoor sports like football, cricket, TT, Carom, Chess, Shuttle Badminton and Gym are available for the students, which serves as a learning facility as part of lifestyle active program, which is an integral part of our Personality Enhancement Program (PEP). The hostel assures a comfortable stay for the students during the course of study. The facilities make the hostel a home away from home.

Library

The Institute has a well-equipped Learning Resources Centre, with a conducive environment for reading, and a seating capacity of 50 users. IT Infrastructure

NSOM has always believed that Information Technology forms an integral part of Management. Every student in the NSOM Campus is facilitated to connect to the digital nervous system of the NSOM knowledge base through a Wi-Fi network across the institutional and residential campus. NSOM's intranet captures all that is learned all that is learned in the institution and disseminates the same to all its stakeholders, on demand.

The labs at NSOM are equipped to handle intensive computing applications and are equipped with the latest hardware for both client and server computing. The laboratories have been so designed that, students can work in a secure, safe and sophisticated system unhindered by erratic power supplies and connectivity. This in turn gives them the opportunity to work 24x7.

Presently the Laboratory has over 50 systems connected to four different servers behind software and hardware-based firewalls. Access to the Internet is provided through round the clock dedicated lease line connectivity of 100 Mbps bandwidth. The software system is run on Windows 10 on the desktops and the server sides are run on Ubuntu and Windows 10. The laboratory also has networked based laser printing for outputs. All the systems are multi-media ready and run application like MS Office and tools for data modelling and simulation.

Learning Management System

NSOM is working towards developing a paper-less system for education leveraging digital technologies. These technological innovations help the institution by ensuring that:

- All instructional and course material is uploaded/updated by the faculty for the students to access every term in the LMS.
- The sessions are recorded and available to students if they miss a class session or if they would like to revisit a session.
- Assignments and quizzes are also enabled.
- Facebook at work is available to faculty and students for more informal interactions as well as to disseminate communication/information related to the course.

The private instance of Facebook popularly referred to as workplace enables the faculty to post announcements, share links of educational videos, case studies and motivational stories.

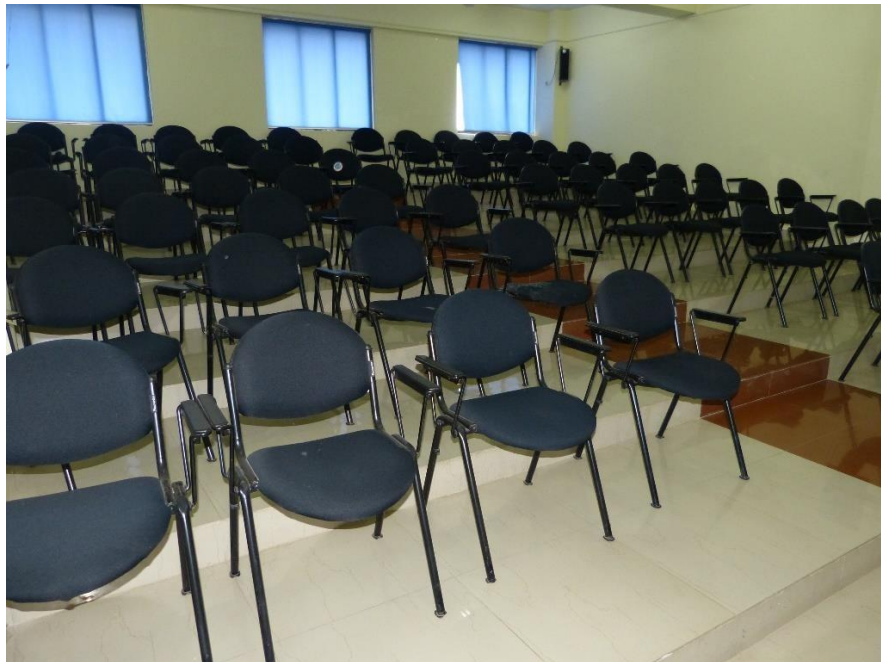

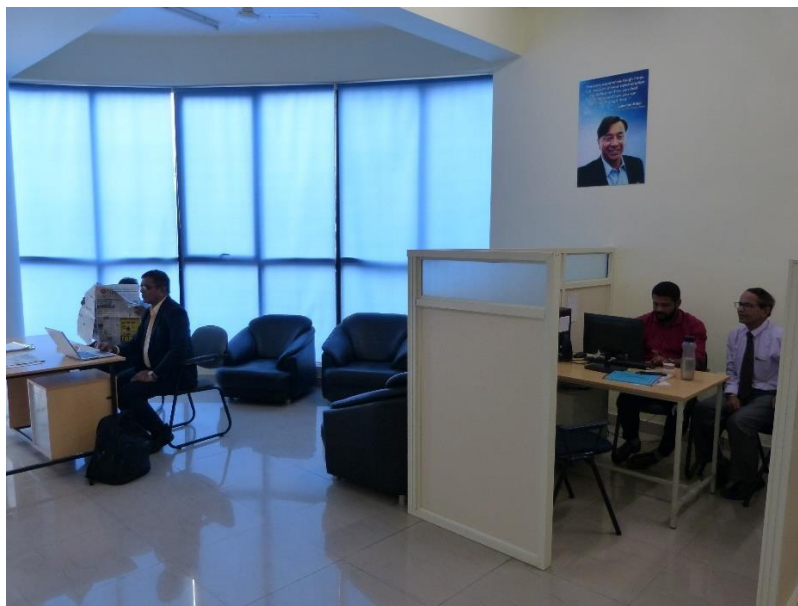
